

## MOBILE-CELLULAR TELEPHONE SUBSCRIPTIONS REPORT AS OF MARCH 2023

## 1. Mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions as of March 2023


The number of active mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions<sup>1</sup> in Rwanda increased from 11,276,091 as of February 2023 up to 11,361,465 SIM cards recorded at the end of March 2023, representing an increase of 0.76%. The postpaid subscriptions increased from 164,739 as of February 2023 to 165,808 SIM cards as of March 2023 whereas the prepaid subscriptions increased to 11,195,657 as of March 2023 in comparison to 11,111,352 SIM cards reported at the end of February 2023. The Table 1 displays the number of active mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions per Mobile Network Operator.




Figure 2: Trend of active mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions by postpaid and prepaid

## 2. Mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions per 100 inhabitants

As of March 2023, the Mobile Penetration Rate that refers to the number of active SIM cards per total projected population have increased up to 85.1% in comparison to 84.8% for February 2023 publications.




Figure 3: Trend of mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions per 100 inhabitants

## 3. Market share for mobile (SIM cards) subscriptions




Figure 4: Market share trends for mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions per operator

As of March 2023, the mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions market shares for MTN Rwanda Ltd decreased by 0.3 percentage points to 63.3% whereas that for AIRTEL Rwanda Ltd increased by the same margin reaching 36.7% in comparison to February 2023 statistics as illustrated by Figure 4.
