

ACTIVE MOBILE-CELLULAR TELEPHONE SUBSCRIPTIONS AS OF MAY 2020

The total number of active mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions¹ in Rwanda decreased from 10,317,279 at the end of April-2020 to 9,667,021 at the end of May-2020, representing a decline of 6.3%. As a result, the mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions per 100 inhabitants² decreased by 5.2 percentage points from 81.5% to 76.3%.

The subscriptions on postpaid plan increased from 56,724 at the end of April-2020 to 59,528 recorded at the end of May-2020 whereas the prepaid subscriptions decreased from 10,260,555 at the end of April-2020 to 9,607,493 as of May-2020.

As of May 2020, the Mobile Penetration Rate which refers to the number of active SIM cards per total projected population was at 76.3 percent.






Figure 2: Market share trends for mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions per operator

The mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions market shares for MTN Rwanda Ltd increased by 4.9 percentage points in May-2020 up to 59.5 percent whereas that for Airtel Rwanda Ltd declined by the same margin to stand at 40.5 percent.






Figure 3: Trend of active mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions from May 2019 to May 2020
