

ACTIVE MOBILE-CELLULAR TELEPHONE SUBSCRIPTIONS AS OF AUGUST 2020

The total number of active mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions¹ in Rwanda increased from 10,056,158 at the end of July-2020 to 10,333,133 SIM cards at the end of August-2020, representing an increase of 2.8%. As a result, the mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions per 100 inhabitants² increased by 2.2 percentage points from 79.4 to 81.6.

The subscriptions on postpaid plan increased from 71,028 at the end of July-2020 to 82,810 recorded at the end of August-2020 whereas the prepaid subscriptions increased from 9,985,130 at the end of July-2020 to 10,250,323 as of August-2020.



As of August 2020, the Mobile Penetration Rate which refers to the number of active SIM cards per total projected population was at 81.6 percent.



At the end of August 2020, the mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions market shares for MTN Rwanda Ltd increased by 0.3 percentage points up to 60.9 percent whereas that for Airtel Rwanda Ltd declined by the same margin to stand at 39.1 percent.




Figure 3: Trend of active mobile-cellular telephone subscriptions from August 2019 to August 2020
