INTRODUCTION

This report is comprised of three parts: part one is about transport of person, part two is about transport of goods and part three is about driving schools. The period under review is from July to September 2014. During this quarter, the number of transport operators and driving schools increased significantly which shows that the environment was conducive to facilitate transport services investors.

PART ONE: TRANSPORT OF PERSONS

The increase in transport was due to many initiatives put in place to encourage the public transport operators to operate in companies or cooperatives. Other initiatives include convening public awareness campaigns encouraging the concerned operators to comply with the laws and regulations in place, as well as increased enforcement measures.

For the period under review, the number of companies and cooperatives increased from 49 in to 56 this portrays an increase of 14.3%. In the third quarter 2014, 49 operators operate within Rwanda and 7 companies operate in cross border countries. These countries are Uganda, Burundi, Tanzania and Kenya.

In the second quarter they were 49 licensed operators operating within the borders of Rwanda using 3,030 cars of different categories. These include 2,021 minibuses, 938 Coasters and 71 buses.

Cars are classified depending on their transportation capacity as follows;

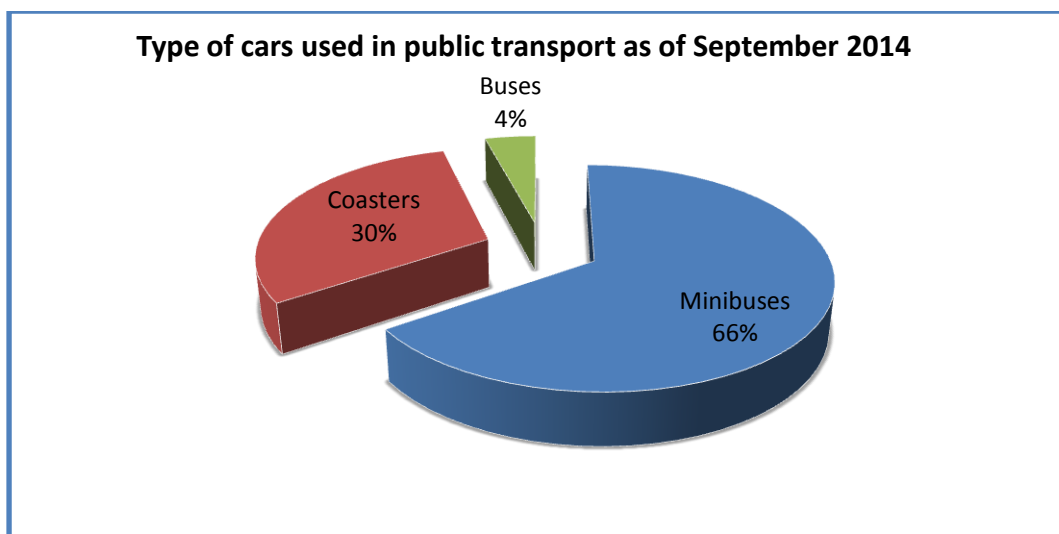
1. Cars with a capacity of transporting 15-19 persons was considered to be a Minibus;
2. Cars with capacity of transporting 20-35 persons was considered to be a Coaster;
3. All cars with a capacity of transporting more than 35 persons were considered to be buses.

The number of licensed cross boarder companies remained unchanged as of September 2014; these 7 companies use 57 buses in transportation of persons. This is mainly due to their efficiency in transporting many passengers.

The commonly used cars by transport companies and cooperatives are minibuses which have the largest market share of 66%, followed by coasters with 30% market share and the least used cars are buses with a market share of 4%.
