


FIGURE 2: NUMBER OF CARS USED BY TRANSPORT COMPANIES




FIGURE 3: TOTAL TRANSPORTATION CAPACITY BY COMPANIES (IN TERMS OF PERSONS) AS OF SEPTEMBER 2012





FIGURE 4: % CAPACITY MARKET SHARE BY NATIONAL TRANSPORT COMPANIES IN THE TRANSPORT OF PERSONS AS OF SEPTEMBER 2012




FIGURE 6: TRANSPORT COMPANIES THAT USE MINIBUSES ONLY AS OF SEPTEMBER 2012




FIGURE 7: TRANSPORT COMPANIES THAT USE COASTERS ONLY AS OF SEPTEMBER 2012




FIGURE 8: TRANSPORT COMPANIES THAT USE MINIBUSES AND COASTERS AS OF, SEPTEMBER 2012





FIGURE 9: TRANSPORT COMPANIES THAT USE COASTERS AND BUSES AS OF SEPTEMBER 2012




FIGURE 10: TREND IN INDIVIDUAL LICENSES AS OF SEPTEMBER 2012
